To build your Human Factors competencies, Level 1 must be completed before Level 2.

Level 1 course:

Aims to develop your knowledge and skills in fundamental Human Factors principles that lead to error and impacts on road user behaviour.

- **Module 1: Safe System**
Understand the safe system approach to road safety
- **Module 2: Human Error**
Identify human error and its effect on road user behaviour
- **Module 3: Human Performance**
Evaluate the factors that affect human performance abilities and limitations
- **Module 4: Fatigue and Workload**
Explain the impact of fatigue and workload on road user behaviour
- **Module 5: Road User Risk Interventions**
How to design interventions for effective road user risk management

Level 2 course:

Aims to develop your knowledge and skills in road user psychology and behaviour

- **Module 1: Motivation**
Discusses how motivation influences road user behaviour
- **Module 2: Emotion**
Evaluates the evidence for the impact of emotions on road user behaviour
- **Module 3: Stress**
Provides a critical review of the impact of stress on road user behaviour and countermeasures
- **Module 4: Individual Differences**
Analysis of the impact of individual differences on road user behaviour
- **Module 5: Behaviour Change**
Design interventions that promote behavioural change
